ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE RELEASE OF COUNTERPART FUND FROM THE PLATEAU STATE GOVERNMENT


I am pleased to formally acknowledge the receipt of the required counterpart funding by the Plateau State Government for the 1st to 4th Quarters of 2025 amounting to **Three Billion, Five Hundred and Fifty-Four Million, Six Hundred and Forty-Two Thousand, Five Hundred and Eighty-Four Naira, Forty-Three Kobo (₦3,554,642,584.43) only.**

These funds will be strategically deployed towards the execution of critical projects aimed at strengthening basic education across Plateau State. The projects include the construction of new classrooms, rehabilitation of existing school infrastructure, drilling of motorized boreholes, and the procurement of essential furniture, vehicles, and motorcycles.

Additional focus areas include the implementation of the Agricultural Education Training Programme (AETP), provision of sporting equipment, enhancement of Quality Assurance processes in teaching and learning, procurement of Teaching and Learning Materials (TLM), strengthening of School-Based Management Committee (SBMC), curriculum procurement and distribution, improvement of Planning and the Education Management Information System (EMIS), development of ICT and Data Platforms, as well as the training of teachers and education officers across the State.

In light of this development, the Plateau State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB) will, in due course, commence the public advertisement and procurement process to enable eligible contractors to participate in competitive bidding. This is in line with our commitment to transparency, accountability, and due process in the execution of these transformative projects.

We extend our profound gratitude to His Excellency, Barr. Caleb Manasseh Mutfwang, the Executive Governor of Plateau State, for his unwavering commitment to the advancement of education and for providing the counterpart funding that enabled the Board to access this significant intervention.
