5.2.1 The programme is designed to deliver improved transparency and accountability in TLM distribution, end-to-end digital tracking from State receipt to beneficiary schools, real-time monitoring through executive dashboards, reliable audit trails, school-level verification of materials received, exception reporting on delayed or unconfirmed deliveries, and standardized reports for Government and development partners. It further provides the verifiable evidence of allocation, receipt, delivery and confirmation TLMs required to support the HOPE-EDU Disbursement-Linked Indicators (DLIs).

5.2.2 Given the centrality of the HOPE-EDU Programme to the strengthening of basic education delivery in Plateau State, there is a need for an institutionalized technology-driven mechanism for tracking TLM distribution. Adoption of the Trace & Track Module as a working document will strengthen governance, accountability and evidence-based decision making and will provide the documentary and operational evidence required for programme monitoring and independent verification under the World Bank PforR financing arrangement in addition to enabling Government to promptly identify and address implementation gaps.

5.3 In view of the above the Hon Commissioner requested Council to:
A. Consider and Adopt:
the Trace & Track System Module for Plateau State as a working document to facilitate its institutionalization and implementation under the HOPE-EDU Programme, and to strengthen the State's capacity to provide credible transparent and verifiable evidence of the delivery of Teaching and Learning Materials in line with the World Bank financing framework.

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B. Approve:

Implementing the Trace & Track Module as an important digital intervention for improving accountability and transparency in the management and distribution of Teaching and Learning Materials across Plateau State.

5.4 Council deliberated extensively on the submission and approved the request at paragraph 5.3(B) to adopt the Trace and Track System Module for Plateau State as a working document, to facilitate its institutionalization and credible, transparent and verifiable evidence of the delivery of Teaching and Learning Materials in line with the World Bank financing framework through a motion moved by Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Transport and seconded by Hon. Commissioner, Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, Plateau State.
